Dear Property Owner,

The City of Chilton currently contracts with Advanced Disposal Services (ADS) to provide curbside recycling pickup for residents of the City of Chilton.

With the current contract, ADS picks up recycling for all residents and businesses that put recyclables curbside.

At the September 1, 2015 City Council meeting, the council approved the NEW recycling contract with ADS for single stream, 96-gallon automated cart recycling collection. The cost to the resident for this new collection will be \$1.50 per month per container or \$18.00 per year.

What this means for you as a taxpayer:

1. ADS will deliver a 96-gallon recycling container to your residence in October or November of this year and you will begin using it immediately. Inside the container will be additional information.
2. There is only one size recycling container available, a 96 gallon can.
3. Recycling collection will continue on the same schedule, every other Tuesday morning pickup.
4. If you currently have a garbage container, you will automatically receive a 96-gallon recycling container. If you have two or more garbage containers, you will receive the same amount of recycling containers.
5. If you share a garbage container with your neighbor, you will share a recycling container.
6. The cost of the recycling container will be included on your property tax bill at a combined cost with the garbage container. Therefore you cannot share a recycling container with your neighbor if you do not currently share a garbage container.

- a. 45 gallon garbage/96 gallon recycling \$123.00,
 - b. 60 gallon garbage/96 gallon recycling \$141.00,
 - c. 90 gallon garbage/96 gallon recycling \$218.00
7. If you would like to change your GARBAGE container size, the deadline to make changes is October 31, 2015. The City must forward all garbage can information to Calumet County in order for them to process property tax bills. (see fees in #6) This deadline is set by Calumet County.
 8. All recyclables (paper, plastic, tin, glass, cardboard) will be placed directly into this 96 gallon container. NO PLASTIC BAGS or string allowed in the container as it is no longer necessary to separate your recyclables.
 9. ADS will still own the recycling container and the container stays with the home just like the garbage container. All damages to the container shall be reported to Chilton City Hall and ADS will repair or replace the container at no charge.
 10. If you are a business and currently do not have the 45, 60 or 90 gallon garbage container with service offered by the City thru ADS, you will need to contract directly with a company to have your recyclables picked up.

Please be advised that Recycling is mandatory in the State of Wisconsin. Citations may be issued by the Chilton Police Department per City of Chilton Municipal Code 20.04.

ADS has provided a sample 96 gallon recycling container to view. It is located at Chilton City Hall and residents may stop in anytime 7:30 am to 4:30 pm to look at it.
